

Lobbyist Information

Go to the **Lobbyist Forms** section on the website for the forms mentioned below and to familiarize yourself with the **Lobbyist Regulation Act**.

1. If you are just going to speak at the Legislature as a citizen, you do not have to register as a lobbyist.
2. If an organization pays you to lobby or speak for it, you must be registered as a lobbyist for that specific organization.
3. The representative of the organization that authorizes you to speak for it must complete the **Lobbyist Authorization Form** for you.
4. You submit the **Lobbyist Registration Form**.
5. If you are not paid by the organization (s) you are lobbying for, you don't have to pay the \$25 registration fee required for each organization.
6. Separate forms are needed for each organization you speak for.
