

## PROCEDURE AND GUIDELINES FOR PUBLIC COMMENT AT A VIDEO CONFERENCE STANDING COMMITTEE MEETING

The following procedures and guidelines are for individuals who would like to make public comments during committee meetings for which public comment periods are provided. If you have any questions about the procedures provided, please contact the Legislative Council Service at (505)986-4600.

Those who would like to view a committee meeting, but do not wish to register to provide public comment, may view the webcast of the committee meeting, available at [www.nmlegis.gov/webcast/](http://www.nmlegis.gov/webcast/).

### Procedure for Making Public Comments at a Video Conference Committee Meeting

At the discretion of the chair of each committee, a public comment period for a committee meeting may be taken.

The committee's web page is accessible through the New Mexico Legislature's website ([www.nmlegis.gov](http://www.nmlegis.gov)). Under the "Committees" tab near the top of the page. All committees will be listed on the right side of the Committees page, and the session committees will be listed on the left.

You can click on the appropriate committee name to access information about that standing committee's upcoming meeting.

Click for public comment (ZOOM)

Click to view committee agenda. Agenda will also have link to view meeting and for public comment.

Clicking on the committee link will take you to the committee page that will:

- Provide zoom link for public comment;
- Provide link to the current committee agenda;
- List scheduled legislation before that committee; and
- list committee members

When your comments are complete, your microphone will be muted and video will be turned off. At your discretion, you may continue to attend the meeting or leave the meeting

- Please be advised that time allocated for public comment is at the discretion of the committee chair and subject to time constraints.
